PART -A

At the beginning of the academic year, the IQAC chalked out the following detailed plan of action for the year 2009-2010.

- > Introduction of New Courses at UG and PG levels.
- > Submission of New Proposals to the UGC for additional grants
- > Invite proposal from various departments for hosting National Seminars
- > Starting Remedial coaching for SC, ST and Minorities.
- > Conducting Guest Lectures
- > Inviting proposals from the staff for attending Refresher Courses and Seminars.
- > Training the students for CRDs under JKC Initiative.
- > Initiating steps to promote Extra-curricular activities under NCC & NSS.

1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution:

At the beginning of the academic year, a meeting of IQAC was held and planned the details of the curricular and extra-curricular activities to be undertaken during the academic year.

On the academic front, after successfully conducting two National Seminars during 2008-2009, it has been decided to conduct another National Seminar with the financial assistance from UGC and all the departments have been asked submit detailed proposals on the topics of student interests for organizing the National Seminar. All the proposals of the departments have been scrutinized and the proposal of Economics Department has been selected for the Seminar. Subsequently, the proposal has been sent to the UGC for approval and financial assistance.

UGC Sponsored National Seminar

A Two-Day UGC Sponsored National Seminar of the Department of Economics on 'Environmental Economics and Sustainable Development' was organized in the college on 5th and 6th of December , 2009. About a hundred delegates from different Universities and Colleges attended the seminar. It was inaugurated by Sri.Virupaksha Goud, the ex-Chief Executive Director, IDBI and former CEO SCHIL. Eminent Economists Prof.Kambli , Prof.Kallur , Prof.M.L.Kantha Rao, Prof.K.Nageshwara Rao , Prof.Sambasiva Rao were among the Resource Persons who presented their papers in five sessions in the seminar. Twenty six papers were presented. They stressed the need to conserve Bio-Diversity by adopting new strategies and techniques for sustainable economic development. The souvenir on this seminar was released by Sri.PV.Raju, Retd Principal of our college on the Republic Day.

Submission of New Proposals to the UGC for additional grants

IQAC constituted a one man committee with Dr.P.Yugandhar Reddy , HOD, Department of Zoology, to study all the UGC Schemes during the XI Plan and recommend those schemes for which detailed proposals can be prepared. After a thorough study , the following UGC Schemes identified by the committee and IOAC considered these schemes and authorized the

principal to get the proposals prepared and submit the same to UGC for necessary action.

The proposals for the following UGC Schemes were prepared and submitted.

- Basic Development Grant
- Additional Development Grant
- Women's Hostel
- Indoor Stadium
- Outdoor Stadium

- Basic Scientific Research (B.S.R)
- College with Potential for Excellence (C.P.E.)

The Institution has since been sanctioned an amount of Rs 60 lakhs for the construction of women's hostel and the first instalment of Rs 20 lakhs has been released. IQAC thanked UGC for sanctioning the grant for the construction of women's hostel. The foundation stone for the women's hostel was laid in April 2010.

The Institution awaits the sanction and release of other UGC grants.

Introduction of New Courses at UG and PG levels.

IQAC reviewed admission status in all the UG and PG Courses and expressed satisfaction with the enrolment. It also considered the feasibility of starting new courses. It was decided that no new course either in UG or PG could be started this academic year.

Remedial coaching for SC, ST and Minorities

The Institution has received the UGC grant under merged scheme for conducting remedial classes for SC, ST and Minority students for three years. Under this programme, Remedial classes in all subjects for Degree SC, ST and Minority students are conducted every day outside college working hours i.e. from 9am to 10am and 4pm to 5pm.

Financial Assistance to the students

Our college students who are economically & socially backward are awarded Scholarships by the state Government.

An amount of Rs 44,47,699 was distributed to 1535 eligible SC,ST, BC and Minority students of our Institution.

The above data pertains to the renewals during this academic year. Same numbers of scholarships are expected for the freshers in the next few months during this academic year itself.

Library as a learning resource:

The Institution has a good library with 54,274 volumes on its racks.

The library subscribes to Eleven Journals, Fifty Magazines and Sixteen News papers. Besides, Internet facility, Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) is available for the staff and the students.

Student Welfare Committees:

Anti-Ragging Committee

Even though rigging is unknown in our Institution , on the direction of the District Collector, IQAC constituted an Anti-Ragging Committee with the Principal as its Chairman, two senior lecturers , warden of boys' hostel and five students from different groups as the members. A meeting of the newly constituted committee was held in the college premises which was attended by the local DSP, CI and all Sub-Inspectors of different police stations of the town. They briefed the students about the stringent laws which will be enforced against the students who indulge in ragging.

Anti-Women Harassment Cell

Even though harassment of girl students and eve-teasing are unknown in our Institution, IQAC constituted an Anti-Women Harassment Cell with the Principal as its Chairman, two senior lecturers, two notable women advocates of the town and five girl student representatives as its members. It is intended to redress the grievances, if any , of the girl students and the staff.

Legal Literacy Club

To generate awareness about the rights and duties of the citizens among general public, IQAC constituted a Legal Literacy Club Cell with the Principal as its Chairman, N S S Program Officers, a reputed lawyer of the town and twenty N S S Volunteers as its members. After attending the legal awareness classes conducted by the lawyer, the N S S Volunteers conduct legal awareness camps as part of their outreach programs.

Red Ribbon Club:

A Red Ribbon Club was formed in the college with Sri.M.Jonathan Wycliffe as its Co-ordinator to generate awareness among the students about AIDS prevention and Blood donation. A meeting of the club was held in the college on 30-11-2009. The meeting was attended by Smt.Sandhya Rani, the Master Trainer and Principal of Noble Junior College, Adoni and the Co-ordinator of Red Ribbon Club Sri.M.Jonathan Wycliffe. The Master Trainer briefed the students about the steps to be taken to protect ourselves from AIDS. She also stressed the need to donate blood.

Proposals from the staff for attending Refresher Courses and Seminars

The Institution has always encouraged the faculty and the students to undertake research in their area of interest. IQAC invited the proposals from the teaching staff who wished to pursue Ph.D under Faculty Development Program (FDP) or wanted to attend Refresher Courses and Seminars. IQAC considered all such proposals from the teaching staff. Given below are the details pertaining to FDP and the participation of the staff in various Seminars and Refresher Courses.

Smt.D.Nalini and Sri.P.Rangantham, Lecturers in Zoology and Sri. M.Bala Swamy, Lecturer in Political Science, submitted a detailed Ph. D proposal in their respective subjects to IQAC. IQAC considered their proposals and forwarded the same to RJD , Kadapa & CCE , Hyderabad for approval.

Smt.D.Nalini, Lecturer in Zoology, presented a paper on "Rollapadu- the great Indian Bustard" at the UGC sponsored National Seminar held at Kittel's Science college, Dharwad in August, 2009.

Kum.W.Indira, Lecturer in Botany, presented a paper on "Ethno-botanical studies in Nallamala forests" at the UGC sponsored National Seminar held at Kittel's Science college, Dharwad in August, 2009.

Sri J.Madhu , Lecturer in Hindi , attended a Refresher Course at Hyderabad Central University, Hyderabad in February, 2009.

Extra-curricular activities

The IQAC has authorized the principal to plan and arrange Guest Lectures and other co-curricular activities in consultation with the HODs of the Departments. Given below are the details of extracurricular activities conducted during this academic year.

Most of the Departments invited eminent scholars in their respective subjects and arranged guest lecturers for the students.

The department of Chemistry arranged Guest lectures by Prof.T.Sreenivasula Reddy and Prof.U.Suryanarayana Rao of SK University, Anantapur to M.Sc (Chemistry) students.

The department of Chemistry organized an Industrial Tour for the M.Sc (Chemistry) final year students. They visited Adani Wilmar Limited, an oil processing factory in Thungabadra on 20/02/2010 and observed all stages involved in oil processing.

Telugu Bhasha Samithi organized a Telugu fete on 03-02-2010. Prof.Devika SK University, Anantapur delivered a lecture on Folk literature in Telugu.

Department of Zoology conducted Blood & HB Testing camp with the assistance of final year B.Sc (B.Z.C) STUDENTS at Aspari in January, 2010.

Department of Economics conducted 44th A.D.Shroff Memorial Elocution Competition for Degree students on November 14, 2008 and prize money of Rs2500/- was given to the winners.

NCC

The Institute has four NCC Platoons with 200 cadets. Sri.T.P.Kambi Reddy , Assistant Physical Director is the NCC Officer for the Boys Platoons and Sri.H.M.Y.Swamy, Lecturer in Physical Education, is the CTO of Girls Units.

Our cadets participated in various camps like NIC , CATC , Tala Sainik Camps organized in different parts of the country. S.U.O Ravi Kumar participated in state level RDC in Secunderabad in January 2010. S.U.O Rafique and Chandrasekhar attended National Integration Camp at Visakhapatnam . J.UO Ram Singh attended state level special National Integration Camp at Rajasthan.

Our cadets also actively took part in social service activities like Blood Group Testing and Donation Camps, Traffic Control and Clean and Green. They assisted Temple administration in Urukunda Temple in Urukunda during Sravanamasam Celebrations.

Cadet Razia Begum of II B.Sc (M.P.C) got Sahara scholarship of Rs12, 000/- this year.

Cadet K.S.Shanti of II B.Sc was awarded N C C Social welfare scholarship of Rs 5, 000/- this year.

This year, 77 cadets appeared for 'B' Certificate Examination and 63 cadets passed the exam. 38 cadets appeared for 'C' Certificate Examination and 28 cadets passed the exam.

NSS

There are three N S S Units with about 125 volunteers in each unit. Sri.G.Chandrashekhar Lecturer in Commerce , Dr.K.Sanjanna, Lecturer in Telugu and M.Jonathan Wycliffe, Lecturer in English are the N.S.S Programme Officers.

ACTIVITIES AND ACHIEVEMENTS OF NSS

The N S S volunteers participated in clean and green activities on the campus on Sundays. They took out Rallies and spread awareness about AIDS and the need for blood donation.

In October 2010, Kurnool District was hit by devastating floods. Adoni and its adjoining towns and villages were among the worst affected regions in Kurnool District. Our N C C Cadets and N S S Volunteers actively participated in relief and rehabilitation activities. They collected rice, bread and biscuits and medicines and distributed them to people living in rehabilitation camps.

Physical Education:

The college has a vast play ground which is used not only by our college students but also by other colleges and organizations for conducting Games and Sports. Our college students participated in many district University and state level competitions and won many laurels for the college.

Our Degree Football Team were runner-up in the SK University level tournament held at Government Degree College, Uravakonda.
