KNOWLEDGE SHARING -ALUMNI

Objective: It is said “Knowledge is Power.” The students try to acquire knowledge from various sources. The Alumni of the Institution provide another source / avenue to acquire knowledge thereby the students on the rolls can benefit from the expertise of the Alumni.

The context: The Alumni of Institution hold highest offices in some of the reputed companies in India and abroad. As a token of gratitude to their Alma mater, they voluntarily offered to share their respective domain expertise with the students who are pursuing different UG Courses in the college at present so that the students can benefit from their insights and help them in planning their future career.

Practice: Thence, a series of online / offline lectures by the distinguished Alumni were planned and successfully organized.

Evidence of success: The response from the students is very encouraging. These lectures on a wide variety of topics helped the students not only to enrich their knowledge but also to choose better career options. The Institution is also providing necessary logistics for the success of the initiative. Depending on the availability/ convenience of the Alumni, more such programs are being planned.

BLOOD DONATION TO THE NEEDY

Objective Donate blood & save lives. Blood is needed for women with complications during pregnancy and childbirth, children with severe anemia, accident victims. The objective of the practice is to help such needy people during emergencies. In case of rare blood groups, it's difficult to find the donors if they had recently donated blood.

The context: Safe blood particularly blood of rare group variants is difficult to get during the emergencies. People face hardships in getting blood during such times.

Practice In order to help such people, the college students are encouraged to register themselves in the list of blood donors who may be contacted whenever needed.

With the help of local medical practitioners, blood group testing camp is organized with the assistance of college NSS Volunteers and NCC Cadets. The students who are willing to donate blood, register their names with the blood group specifically mentioned in it. Whenever a medical emergency arises, these personnel contact the NSS Officers to get the info regarding donors for blood donation.

Evidence of success: People in the need of blood contacted the donors in the college and received blood from the donors thereby saving precious lives.

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BalikaThelusuko- AProgram to enlighten the girl students

Objective: To generate awareness about health & hygiene among the girl students who live in the ResidentialHostels under difficult conditions

The context: It has been observed that the girl students, particularly hailing from rural areas, stay in different hostels and they are not aware of many matters pertaining to health and social issues. There is a need to sensitise them about these issues and improve their lifestyle.

Practice: One hundred girl students of the Institution underwent a special training under the trained tutors selected 24 ResidentialHostels and spent three Nights and tried to educate the girl students of these hostels about various issues concerning their life under *balikaathelusuko* program of ICDS (Integrated Child Development Services). Under this program, the girl students were sensitized about Nutrition, hygiene, various social evils like child marriages, etc . The whole program was spearheaded by the girl students of the Institution

Evidence of success: The success of the program is evidenced from the fact that it was well received from the Inmates of all those hostels and appreciated by the bureaucrats and the general public as well. It brought about a quality change in the lifestyles of the inmates.

PURSUING IGNOU CERTIFICATE COURSES

Objective: The students have to broaden their horizons of knowledge in their allied fields of study for better career opportunities. Encouraging and motivating the students to pursue certificate courses offered by IGNOU is a step in that direction.

The context: In this competitive world, it is said, knowledge is power. It is better for the students to enrich their allied fields of study. IGNOU provides an avenue where they can pursue different certificate courses and it also provides the students get extra qualification besides a regular degree.

Practice: There is Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) Study centre on the campus. The IGNOU invites applications for various Courses offered two times in a year viz in June & December. Regular Degree students are encouraged to register for any certificate course so that they can improve their qualification without having to attend classes on any given working day.

Evidence of success: As result of initiatives by the staff who also discharge their duties as Counselors in IGNOU, many regular students are evincing interest to pursue certificate courses. During this year (2018-2019) about 120 students registered for different certificate courses and most of them have successfully completed the courses.


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
